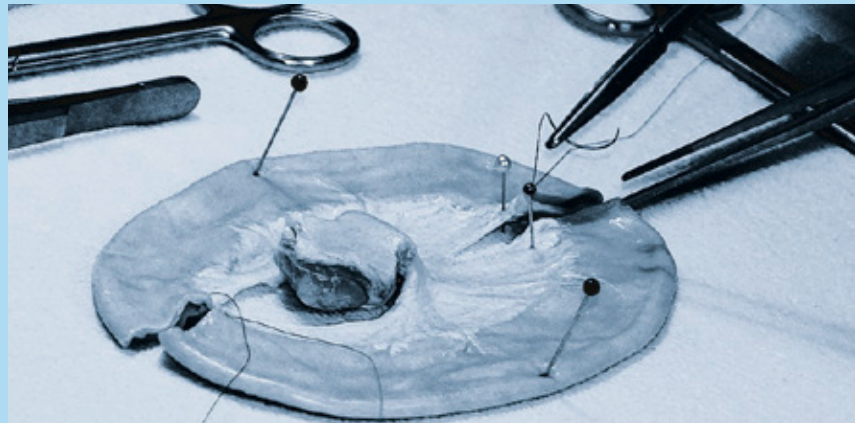

Objectives of the Course

Acquire knowledge, develop and improve practical skills in safe standard surgical techniques, both in conventional and laparoscopic surgery, as demonstrated by and practiced with international faculty.

Course Structure

The Basic and Intermediate Courses are divided into 3½ days open surgery on suture- and anastomosis techniques in the gastro intestinal tract, followed by 2½ days on laparoscopic surgery and techniques. Lectures related to the practical exercises are scheduled daily in the morning and afternoon.

Advanced Course Specialized surgical techniques in colorectal or/and hernia surgery will be instructed by well experienced specialists. Each course module will last for 3 days and can be booked jointly or separately. The number of participants is limited to 24 only!

Assessment Participants will be continually assessed in all exercises by the instructors. Instructors will be assessed by the participants. The final assessment at the end of the course is mandatory to obtain certificate of participation.

- Laparoscopic exercises using pelvitrainers: suture techniques, cholecystectomy, appendectomy, antireflux procedures
